#### **BACKGROUND**

District A Phase 1 Septic-to-Sewer Design completed, we understand that the County desires to reduce neighborhood impacts on Elgin Boulevard. The scope of services to be performed shall consist of a combination gravity/low-pressure system component in Sewershed 5 to address these concerns. Per our meetings, we are providing the Scope of Services below to complete the design modifications discussed with the County. The final deliverable under this Scope of Services will include updated 100% design documents, updated technical specifications, and an updated Engineer's Opinion of Probable Construction Cost (EOPCC).

#### SCOPE OF SERVICES

#### Task 1. Project Management

Maintain a financial and information management system for the project. Monitor the project progress and manage the project in conformance with the contract.

- Prepare a project schedule
- Documentation: Prepare and distribute meeting minutes for design review meetings

Task 3. Design, Construction Drawings, Permitting, & Bid Documents

#### 3.4B Permit Submittals

 Update the FDEP Wastewater Collection/Transmission System permit to reflect the lowpressure design modifications agreed to with the County. This task will include submitting the permit application and responding to one Request for Additional Information (RAI).

#### **Deliverables**

Provide Coastal with the draft permit application and permit drawings for review and approval before submitting the FDEP permit modification.

#### 3.6B 100% Design Document Updates for Grinder System

Update the design plans, technical specifications, and EOPCC to reflect the agreed upon modifications. This will include updating the Sewershed 5 plan/profile sheets, civil detail sheets, Individual Lot Sewer Hook Up Exhibits, bid form, and measurement and payment specification section, and adding low-pressure system technical specifications to the bid package. At the County's request, Coastal can also facilitate a site visit to observe the proposed design modifications in use.





#### Design modifications will include:

- Four (4) duplex grinder stations added
- Approximately 1,150 linear feet (LF) of small diameter force main added
- Five manholes removed
- Approximately 3,500 LF of gravity main removed
- Approximately 31 plan sheets and one detail sheet updated

#### **Deliverables**

Provide updated documents for submission to the County. Two County submittals, 90% Draft and 100% Findal, with one set of County Comments to be addressed after the 90% Submittal.

#### **Clarifications and Assumptions**

- 1. System layout modifications beyond those agreed to during the 100% District A Phase 1 Septic-to-Sewer design review meeting are not included in this scope and fee.
- 2. The proposed system will not modify the existing sewershed boundaries; therefore, no modifications to the lift stations are required or included.
