Resolution Declaring End to Drought Emergency and Repeal of Resolution No. 2023-61

BRIEF OVERVIEW

Due to the recent heavy rains, the Keetch-Byram Drought Index (KBDI) has decreased to under 500 and has been forecasted for a higher chance of rain over the next several days. Therefore, the Hernando County Fire Chief supports a repeal of the current open burning ban in effect for the unincorporated areas of Hernando County.
