TITLE

Enabling Resolution Implementing May 2024 as Code Compliance Month

BRIEF OVERVIEW

Attached is a proposed resolution implementing May 2024 as Code Compliance Month per Hernando County Ordinance, Chapter 2, Article III, Section 2-57. The Board adopted this Ordinance as a mechanism to annually help Hernando County citizens with a financial incentive to bring properties with outstanding liens into compliance. Citizens who have outstanding liens on their property and who meet the qualifications of the Ordinance will have the opportunity to make application during the month of May for a reduction and satisfaction of fifty (50) percent of each qualifying lien.
