CONCLUSIONS

- 1. The applicant has requested a variance to reduce side setback from 10' to 5' to accommodate an accessory structure.
- 2. Upon review of the proposed variance, it appears that the reduction for side setback is not consistent with the ordinance for the zoned area and will be detrimental to the development pattern of the neighborhood nor injurious to the surrounding community.
- 3. It is recommended that the Board review the request, take public comment, and make a finding that the request is not consistent with the review criteria of Appendix A, Article IV, Section 13B (5) Special regulations.
