Resolution Ratifying Approval of Revised Variance Submitted by Brian Garrison and Vicki McMahan a/k/a Florida Coast Shrimp, LLC

BRIEF OVERVIEW

A resolution ratifying denial of rear setback reduction of 20' to 6" and a side setback reduction from 20' to 10'. Side setback will be 10' rear setback will be 15' for the building and 6" for carport/canopy.

REQUEST

Resolution approval to accept side setback from 20' to 10', rear setback from 20' to 15' for the building and 6" for carport/canopy.

GENERAL LOCATION

Gulf Coast Ret, Unit 3, Blk 23, Lots 1 & 2

BOARD ACTION: On August 23, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners voted 3-2 to deny the petitioner's request to reduce rear setback from 20' to 6" and a side setback reduction from 20' to 10' on property zoned C2.
