BRIEF OVERVIEW

Request:

Establish a Master Plan on Property Zoned CPDP (Combined Planned Development Project) with deviations

General Location:

Northeast side of Ponce De Leon Boulevard (US Highway 98), approximately 2200' southeast of its intersection with the Suncoast Parkway

P&Z Action:

On September 12, 2022, the Planning and Zoning Commission voted 5-0 to postpone the petitioner's request to their October 10, 2022, hearing in order to provide the petitioner additional time to review staff comments.
