## **BRIEF OVERVIEW**

## Request:

Rezoning from PDP(OP)/Planned Development Project (Office Professional) to PDP(SF)/Planned Development Project (Single Family)

#### **General Location:**

South side of Maderia Street, approximately 142'west of Mariner Boulevard

#### P&Z Action:

On August 8, 2022, the Planning and Zoning Commission recommend the Board of County Commissioners adopt a resolution approving the petitioner's requested rezoning from PDP (OP)/Planned Development Project (Office Professional) to PDP(SF)/Planned Development Project (Single Family) with unmodified performance conditions.

## **LEGAL NOTE**

The Board has the authority to make the requested rezoning decision pursuant to Chapters 125 and 163 Florida Statutes. The Applicable Criteria for a Zoning District Amendment are contained in Appendix A (Zoning Code), Article VI. The Applicable Criteria for a PDP are found in Appendix A (Zoning Code), Article VIII. The Zoning District Amendment must be consistent with the Comprehensive Plan.

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt a resolution approving the petitioner's requested rezoning from PDP(OP)/Planned Development Project (Office Professional) to PDP(SF)/Planned Development Project (Single Family) with unmodified performance conditions in accordance with the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission.
