TITLE

Authorization to Evaluate Vendor Proposals for Hernando County Public Safety Training Facility (Contract No. 23-R0003018/PH)

BRIEF OVERVIEW

On April 12, 2023, the Procurement Department issued a Request for Proposals (RFQ No. 23-R00030/PH) for the Hernando County Public Safety Training Facility.

The solicitation was sent to two thousand five hundred eleven (2,511) contractors and downloaded by sixty-two (62).

Six (6) proposals were received on the opening date of May 15, 2023, from the following firms (in alphabetical order):

- Florida Architects, Inc.
- Forefront Architecture & Engineering
- HDR Architecture, Inc.
- KMF Architects
- Wannemacher Jensen Architects, Inc.

The following members of the Professional Services Review Committee (PSRC) met on June 7, 2023, to review and rank the six (6) written proposals.

The selection process was conducted using the guidelines set forth in Section 287.055, Florida Statutes.
