Master Plan Revision Petition Submitted by Hillpointe, LLC, on behalf of John Grubbs (H2227)

BRIEF OVERVIEW

Request:

Establish a Master Plan on Property Zoned PDP(MF)/Planned Development Project (Multifamily) and Property Zoned PDP(SU)/Planned Development Project (Special Use) with Deviations

General Location:

Western terminus of Astaire Lane

P&Z Action:

On June 13, 2022, the Planning and Zoning Commission voted 5-0 to recommend the Board of County Commissioners adopt a resolution approving the petitioner's request to Establish a Master Plan on Property Zoned PDP(MF)/Planned Development Project (Multifamily) and Property Zoned PDP(SU)/Planned Development Project (Special Use) with Deviations and <u>unmodified</u> performance conditions.

The Board has the authority to make the requested rezoning / Master Plan Revision decision pursuant to Chapters 125 and 163 Florida Statutes. The Applicable Criteria for a PDP are found in Appendix A (Zoning Code), Article VIII. The Zoning District Amendment / Master Plan Revision must be consistent with the Comprehensive Plan.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board adopt a resolution approving the petitioner's request to establish a Master Plan on Property Zoned PDP(MF)/Planned Development Project (Multifamily) and Property Zoned PDP(SU)/Planned Development Project (Special Use) with Deviations and the following unmodified performance conditions in accordance with the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission.
