### **TITLE**

Ratification of Proclamation No. 2023-07 Extending Declaration of Local State of Emergency Due to Hurricane Idalia

### **BRIEF OVERVIEW**

A State of Local Emergency was extended for a period of seven (7) days for Hernando County, effective October 7, 2023, through October 14, 2023, with Proclamation No. 2023-07. Proclamation No. 2023-07 was signed by the Board Chairman in conjunction with the Executive Policy Group on October 6, 2023. Attached is a copy of Proclamation No. 2023-07.
