My name is Matthew Patsch and I am writing you in reference to a concern I have with emergency vehicles gaining access to a growing neighborhood. I have attached a map for reference in the Royal Highlands area.

Currently, Dusky Warbler Rd is a paved road that was never completed to Centralia Rd. As that stands, emergency vehicles have to travel west on Centralia and pass Dusky Warbler Rd, to turn north on Lelani Dr, in order to turn east onto Ruffed Grouse Rd, and finally back to Dusky Warbler Rd, in order to access the growing neighborhoods. This takes 7 minutes time which is detrimental during an emergency situation.

I have asked the county to look into this and have gotten nowhere. I was told that the land was private property and they couldn't complete the road because of that. On the map, the yellow line shows land owned by SWFMD which the county could purchase in order to complete the road.

Vehicles use the incomplete area of the road all the time and get stuck constantly because GPS takes you that way.

I am asking that you please look into this for all of us in the neighborhood. Thank you and I greatly appreciate your time.
